Question: How does a church present a holistic view of worship for every age and stage? How do we redirect the hearts and affection of people toward God?

HE INHABITS OUR PRAISES: Worship is "attributing worth to God" and is one of the most exciting things we can be a part of as believers. Worship gives us the opportunity to encounter God and declare our loyalty to Him. Psalm 22:3 (KJV) says that God inhabits our praises. Many times, it is in a time of worship that He begins to speak to our heart individually and corporately.

DELIGHT IN HIM: Psalm 37:4 instructs us to delight ourself in the Lord. Delighting in Him is what makes a relationship with God different from a mere religious mindset. Worship is not something we *have* to do but is something we *get* to do.

CONSUMER MENTALITY: Today's church often has a consumer mentality. This keeps our focus drawn inward and limits us from always offering worship freely to God.

CREATE SPACE: Create room in our schedules to worship corporately and allow time to linger in God's presence. If people get a taste of God's presence, they will want more: "Taste and see that the Lord is good" (Psalm 34:8). And they will never want to walk away from Him.

Question: How do we prioritize God in our daily living through worship?

INDIVIDUAL WORSHIP ENRICHES CORPORATE WORSHIP: Teach people to worship at home and to come together as a family for times of worship. Practicing the daily experience of individual worship powerfully enriches our corporate worship experience.

WORSHIP EXPRESSES GRATITUDE: Worship is an expression of our gratitude to God. We create an atmosphere of worship and intimacy when we walk in the Spirit and weave worship into our daily routine. This creates an atmosphere for His presence to permeate our life, home, and workplace.



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A WEAPON AGAINST THE ENEMY: Worship is a form of warfare that we can use as a weapon against the enemy and his schemes. Teach others how to fight the enemy by using what God gave us through the heart of David in the Book of Psalms.

WORSHIP AS A LIFESTYLE: Model to others how to live with worship as a lifestyle Monday through Sunday and not just something we do to check off the list.

Discussion Questions

Take a few minutes to continue this conversation with your team

- 1. Do we create an atmosphere of worship in our homes Monday through Saturday, and then enter God's presence corporately with prepared hearts on Sunday?
- 2. Have we found that precious place where we "delight in the Lord," and does our life of obedience become our act of worship?
- 3. Are we carving out space in our services to come together and worship corporately, not being in a hurry, so the Holy Spirit may speak to our hearts?
